
Data Collection and analysis

Data has been collected by preparation of Google form and has been circulated to the students of all courses. The details of the analysis is as follows:


Student feedback

1. Student profile Course- wise classification of students




Total 472 responses were received across all the courses, out of which 45.3% are from B. Com, 32.8% from BCA, 17.4% are from BBA and 4.5% are from M.Com

2. Quality of the curriculum and syllabi of their respective course





According to this 16.5% of the students has perceived the students to be excellent, 39.6% of the students consider as very good and 39% as good. 3. Extent of syllabus covered by the faculty members during the academic year





5. Usage of Teaching aids and ICT in the class by the faculty members




7. Providing opportunity to the student in research activities





Content and Learning of Add-on Course offered at College 472 responses





The chart indicates the about the opportunities to the students available outside the classroom learning in terms of guest lecturers, seminars, workshops, conferences, competitions, industrial visits, internships and such others. According to the above response, 20.6% of the responses record as excellent, 33.1% show as very good, 31.8% of them respond as good. 10% of them has responded as fair and 4.5% as poor.





The above chart indicates the overall experience in learning of the students of all programs and courses. According to the above response, 20.6% of the responses record as excellent, 36.9% show as very good, 36.7% of them respond as good. ---- of them has responded as fair and ---- as poor.

Major observations and recommendations

- With regard to the quality of the syllabus and its contents, majority of the students has appreciated it.
- In respect to the course delivery by the faculty members across all the programs, more than 90% has accepted it but marginal section of the students has considered as fair / poor. There is always a scope for the improvement to faculty members.
 Steps are initiated program-wise to identify and improve the quality of course delivery
- Usage of teaching aid and ICT as a teaching pedagogy in addition to the conventional method, there has been a considerable percentage of students accepting it. There are few practical oriented / problems solving courses which require the traditional method of teaching.

It is recommended to faculty members to continue to use ICT as one of the teaching aid

 With regard to research activities initiated by the college at under graduate level is a challenge. But our college has successfully initiated research activities in terms of conducting workshops, encouraging students to prepare and present research papers in conferences and such other things has brought a great level of acceptance from the students of all programs

It is recommended to continue with more interesting activities

- Though our college is affiliated to Bengaluru City University, and are bound by its syllabus, institution has introduced add-on courses on emerging technologies. This has been given a thumbs up by the students. Of course, to a fringe section of students might feel the burden as it is compulsory to take up these courses
- With regard to extent of syllabus covered by the faculty members, more than 90% of the faculty has been able to cover. It also indicates that a small percentage of them are lagging behind.

Steps are recommended to be initiated to ensure that the margin of the same will be narrowed down

 Opportunities to the students for out of the class room learning are ample which has been accepted and appreciated by the students.

It is recommended to continue with such activities

- The overall experience of the students is good. There is a scope for further improvement here and hence it is recommended to the faculty member to enhance their overall effectiveness



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


Analysis Report of the feedback received from Teachers

Data has been collected by preparation of Google form and has been circulated to the alumnus. The details of the analysis are as follows:




Analysis

2. Curriculum and Syllabus are need based


1. You are providing feedback for which course?


3. The Course outcome are well defined and clear


4. Sufficient number of relevant reading materials and digital resources are available in the library

5. The course has good balance between the theory and application




6. The syllabus of this course will upgrade our knowledge and perspective in the subject area

7. I have the freedom to propose, modify, suggest and incorporate new topics in the syllabus through proper forum




8. I have the freedom to adopt new techniques/education tools/strategies in teaching


9. I am able to achieve the required course outcome


Analysis report based on Employer Feedback

Data has been collected by preparation of Google form and has been circulated to the alumnus. The details of the analysis are as follows:


1. The Technical Knowledge of the students is good.




2. The Curriculum and Syllabus provide sufficient knowledge in the area of study

Analysis



The above chart depicts that students are able to work as a part of the team. The respondents 66.7% agreed to the statement. Further 33.3% strongly agreed.




4. The student maintains cordial relation with Peers and Seniors


The above chart says that the student maintains cordial relation with Peers and Seniors. The respondents 66.7% agreed to the statement and 66.7% strongly agreed to the statement.

The above chart portrays that whether the communication skills of the students are good. The respondents 66.7% agreed to the statement and 33.3% strongly agreed to the statement.




6. Students Volunteer to get new initiatives taken up by the Institution

Students have been made office bearers for 32 activity centres to ensure they work as a team to meet common objectives.



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
ANALYSIS OF ALUMNUS FEEDBACK

Data has been collected by preparation of Google form and has been circulated to the alumnus. The details of the analysis is as follows:


1. The curriculum and Syllabus content were appropriate for my placement/higher education

2. Sufficient number of Co- Curricular activities were arranged during my study period






Analysis

3. The Institution/faculty members helped me in placement /higher education






5. The learning ambience at the institute is good

the statement. Further, 3.8% of respondents Diagreed to the statement. Finally, 1.5% strongly disagreed towards the statement.




6. The institution provides sufficient opportunity to participate in extracurricular activities

7. The Curriculum accomodates courses with experimental learning(hands On)


