Introduction





521 responses




Analysis




Analysis

Course Delivery by Faculty Members in the class



Usage of Teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty members to facilitate teaching 521 responses




Analysis




Analysis






Analysis



Major observations and recommendations

- With regard to the quality of the syllabus and its contents, majority of the students has appreciated it. The syllabus followed by the college is as per our affiliated university BCU. By the introduction of NEP multi-disciplinary and open elective are introduced
- More than 80% of the faculty members have completed the syllabus within the stipulated time. It will be ensure that the percentage will increase to 100%
- In respect to the course delivery by the faculty members across all the programs, more than 85% has accepted it but marginal section of the students has considered as fair / poor. There is always a scope for the improvement to faculty members. Steps are initiated program-wise to identify and improve the quality of course delivery
- Usage of teaching aid and ICT has been a part of teaching pedagogy. In addition to the conventional method, there have been a considerable percentage of students accepting it. There are few practical oriented / problems solving courses which require the traditional method of teaching. It is recommended to faculty members to continue to use ICT as one of the teaching aid

- Institution follows a fair process in assessing the student performance. There are a marginal section of students who feel otherwise. Steps need to be taken in order to ensure that 100% of the students accepts our process
- College has successfully initiated research activities in terms of conducting workshops, encouraging students to prepare and present research papers in conferences and such other things has brought a great level of acceptance from the students of all programs It is recommended to continue with more interesting activities
- Though our college is affiliated to BCU, institution has introduced add-on courses on emerging technologies. This has been given thumbs up by the students. Of course, to a fringe section of students might feel the burden as it is compulsory to take up these courses
- Opportunities to the students for out of the class room learning are ample which has been accepted and appreciated by the students. It is recommended to continue with such activities
- The overall experience of the students is good. There is a scope for further improvement here and hence it is recommended to the faculty member to enhance their overall effectiveness

Action Taken

- Though we are affiliated to BCU and are bound to follow its syllabus, college has introduced emerging technology courses to bridge the gap
- ICT enabled class room has been increased to ensure that it used to its full extent
- Students are encouraged and supported to present and publish papers. Few of them have presented and the same has been published
- Steps has been taken to ensure that assessment will be made in all fairness








Analysis




Analysis




Analysis




Analysis




Analysis




Analysis




Analysis



- The majority of the respondents opine that the syllabus will upgrade the knowledge and subject area.
- Most of the respondents responded say they are able to adopt new techniques/education tools/strategies in teaching. The teachers can also use the e-leaning sources for the students.
- Majority of the respondents feel that, they have limited scope to change/alter the syllabus but liberty to use various teaching pedagogy
- It is observed that the majority of the respondents have initiated the steps to assist to slow learners and /or advanced learners. There is always a scope for improvement in this area by giving regular assignments and focusing more on slow learners helps the institution to improve the results.

Action Taken

- Peer teaching and remedial coaching has been introduced to facilitate slow learners.
- Teachers continue to use ICT enabled teaching.
- Since the University revises the syllabus once in 4-5 years, The College initiates various add on and certificate courses which are contemporary in nature and job oriented


Data Collection and analysis




Analysis




Analysis




Analysis




Analysis




Analysis




Analysis












Analysis








Analysis
