Highlights of IQAC

- 1. SSMRV College has Collaborated with an international university Husson University, USA for offering an International MBA Programme for students of B. Com and BBA. The same is effective from academic Year 2022-23.
- 2. The College has organized an international conference in association with Tshwane University of Technology, Pretoria Campus, South Africa, Blue Crest University College. Monrovia, Liberia and The Institute of Cost and Management Accountants of India. The same was organized by PG Dept of Commerce and the same was initiated via IQAC.
- 3. IQAC has initiated a weekly Corporate Guest Lecture series for all UG and PG Programmes. Every week students would get an opportunity to listen and interact with a resource person from the corporate sector who would give them a real life insight into the respective area of Management. There were about 15 such guest lectures conducted for all UG and PG students. The guest lectures have also been uploaded in our YouTube channel.
- 4. SSMRV College has introduced a unique work-earn programme called Work Integrated Learning Programme (WILP). Under this programme, the students who are selected would get an opportunity to work in an organization (after their college hours) and get paid for the same. The organization would take care of the fees payment. This programme would ensure that students are financially independent and also they gain industry experience while they are still studying.
- 5. The College organized one international seminar, one international conference, five national level seminars and four National workshops.

- 6. An awareness programme on National Education Policy was organized exclusively for all stakeholders.
- 7. The Research club, under the Dept of Commerce organized two workshops on Research Visibility and Research gate.

- 9. A guest lecture series was organized for the students of First year UG (First Batch of NEP)
- 10. SSMRV College participated in the NIRF Best College ranking survey 2022

- 12. IQAC has also initiated ISR activities through various activity centres such as NSS,NCC, CCS among others.
