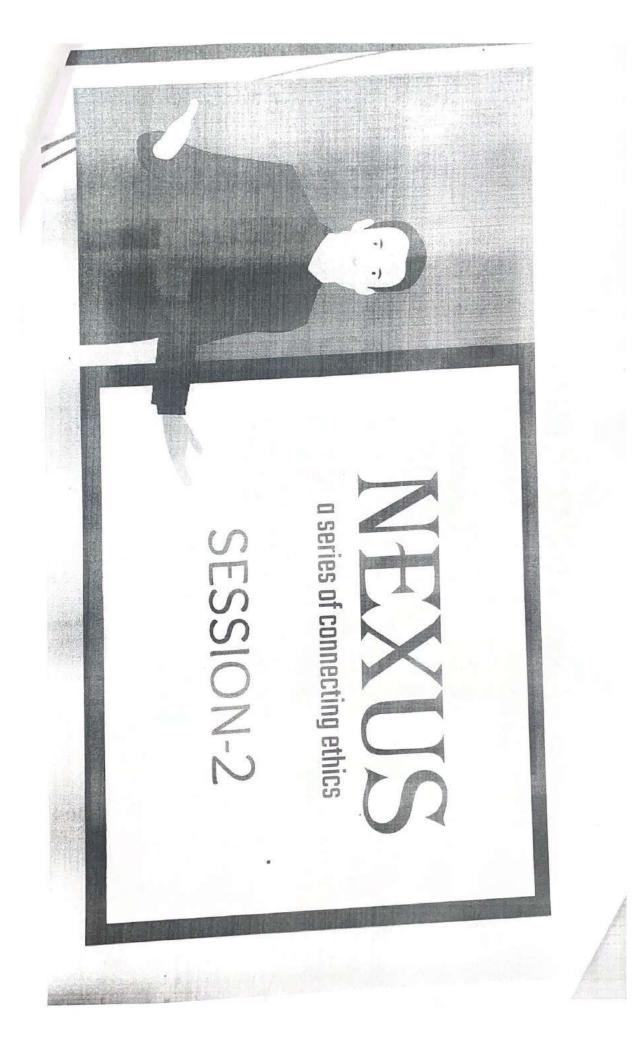
In the NEXUS 2 session the following topics were explained by the presenters:

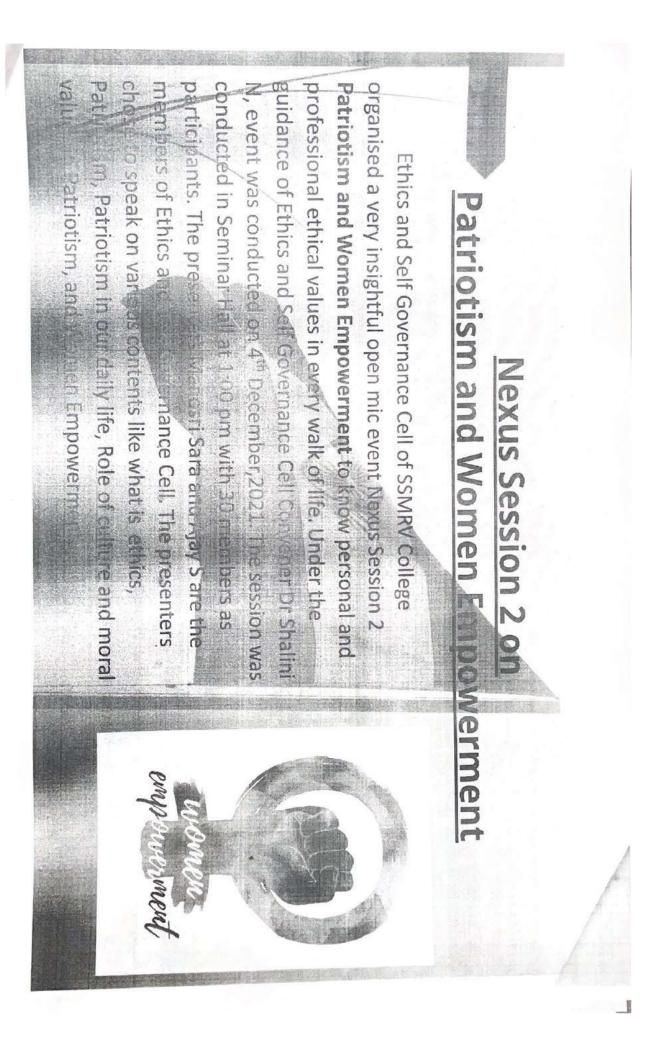
- What is Ethics?

The Speaker forthe day was Dr. Bhavya H B, Medical officer Govt. Naturopathy and Yoga dispensary, Master yoga trainer at National Ayush Mission, Karnataka.

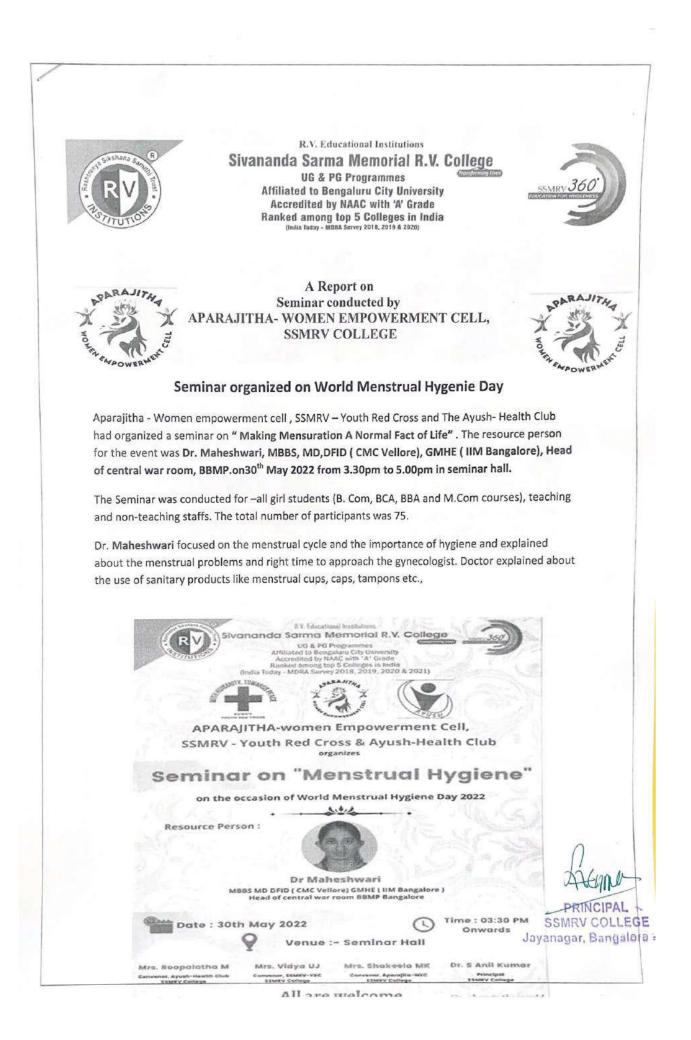


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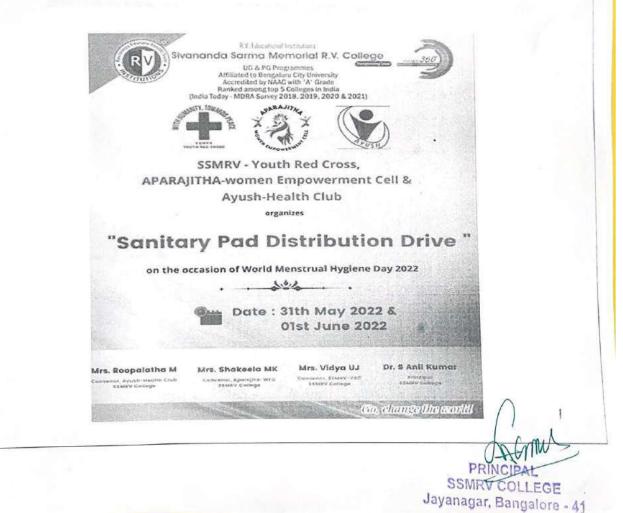

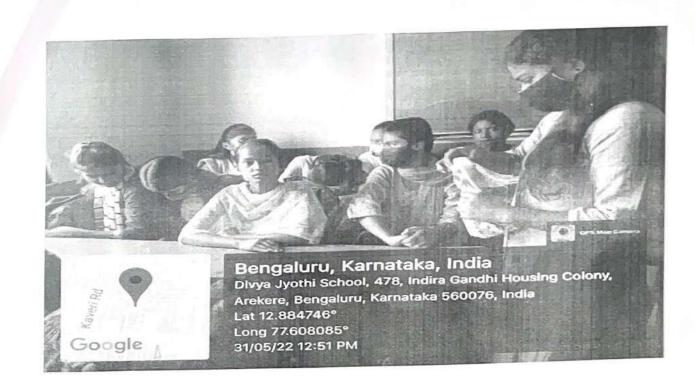
Distribution of sanitary pads:
