

	Morning Session: Backward course design is a measurable statements that articulate at the beginning what students should know, be able to do, or value as a result of taking a course or completing a programme.
	Afternoon session: Resource person spoke about the Rubric. Later a hands-on session on framing learning outcome was conducted. All teaching staff from different courses were asked to get the lesson plan and draft the leaning outcome. Resource person stressed on the terminologies to be used while framing the lesson plan.
	Resource Person emphasized on tips to be used while constructing learning outcomes. Instructors can use the six major categories to organize their lesson plans and assignments into varying levels of difficulty, resulting in a course that guides students through increasingly more complex material.

	Additionally, instructors can use the verbs associated with Bloom's taxonomy to develop clear learning objectives associated with a specific level of difficulty.
	Building learning objectives using Bloom's cognitive, affective and Psychomotor domain based taxonomy can help instructors link learning activities with specific levels of complexity.

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







