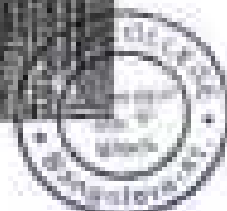


## VISIT TO RBI REPORT

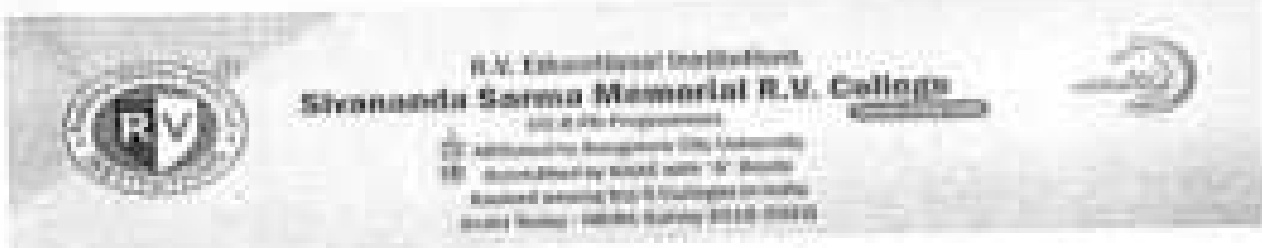

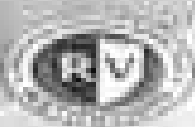

The Speakers for the day were Dr. Radha Rao, Senior Consultant (Obstetrics & Gynecology), Apollo cradle and children's hospital, Bangalore And Dr. Vijaya Geetha, Counselling Psychologist, Apollo CM Family.

Coordinating was done by Ms. Zahera Begum, Member, Aparajitha-WEC, SSMRV College.

**Welcoming:** The event started with a Welcome Speech by Mrs. Shakala M K, Co-ordinator, Aparajitha-Women Empowerment Cell, SSMRV College.

**Principal Address:** Dr. S. Anil Kumar, Principal SSMRV College, addressed the gathering and inspired the Students with his motivational words.

**About the Talk:**

Dr. Radha Rao briefed the gathering on the pain of Adolescence has been recognized as a special period that requires specific attention as it marks the onset of menarche, an important milestone, and hence good hygienic practices during menstruation are crucial to maintain a healthy life.

Dr. Radha Rao even stated that reusable pads experienced improvements in comfort and reliability. Puberty-education sessions should increase attention to body awareness and include strategies to address a wider range of practical menstrual challenges, including pain management. Hence Dr. Radha said there has been increasing emphasis on the potential for interventions addressing this issue to improve girls' health, education and psychosocial wellbeing.

She stressed that anxiety was reflected in girls' recollections of menarche. Reproductive tract infections, which has become a silent epidemic that devastates women's life is closely interrelated with poor menstrual hygiene. Therefore, proper menstrual hygiene and correct perceptions and beliefs can protect the womenfolk from this suffering.

Later in her talk she emphasized that- Before bringing any change in menstrual practices, the girls should be educated about the facts of menstruation, physiological implications, about the significance of menstruation and development of secondary sexual characteristics, and above all, about proper hygienic practices with selection of disposable sanitary menstrual absorbent.

Dr. Vijaya Geetha the psychologist spoke on both anxiety and depression are on the rise in teens, and anxiety is currently the top reason why a parent brings a child to a mental health professional. Because an untreated anxiety disorder is one of the top predictors of developing depression as an adolescent or young adult, the need for prevention.

Dr. Vijaya Geetha stressed on working together: essential collaboration with parents, schools, and outside providers she even stressed not to use of electronic devices and social networks.

The session was followed by an interactive question and answer session with the Participants And distribution of Free Reusable cloth pads to all female student participants.

The APARAJITHA - Women Empowerment Cell, SSMRV College organized a Workshop on "Gender Mainstreaming" on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2022 in Seminar Hall, SSMRV College - Marking the Occasion Human Rights Day. The Speaker for the day was Ms. Veena Jain, Founder of Jyothsna, Counselling Psychologist and relationship coach, Associated with Indian Airforce, Yelahanka, Karnataka.

Cooperating was done by Ms. Bhaskartha, Member, Women Empowerment Cell, Aparajitha, SSMRV College.

Welcoming: The event started with a Welcome Speech by Mrs. Bhaskartha M K, Co-ordinator, Aparajitha-Women Empowerment Cell, SSMRV College.

**Principal Address:** Dr. S. Arul Kumar, Principal SSMRV College, addressed the gathering and inspired the Students with his motivational words.

**About the Talk:**

Ms. Veena Jain briefed the gathering on the point of integrating gender concerns in policy decisions and their practical implementation is the responsibility of public authorities and institutions. Gender training is not a difference. If implemented systematically it facilitates more efficient actions towards gender equality and a positive change in the attitudes of policymakers.

Ms. Veena Jain even stated that Gender equality competence in public policies refers to the skills, attributes and behaviours that people need in order to mainstream gender effectively. It requires recognition that no political and organisational action is gender neutral and that women and men are affected by policies in different ways. It implies theoretical knowledge on gender-related concepts and practical knowledge of the various tools that can be used to mainstream gender. It is not about 'women's issues' only, but seeks to foster reflection on the stereotypes and gendered roles of both women and men, with the aim of understanding what constitutes gender-neutral equality. To date, a number of efforts have been made to develop gender competence within public policy organizations.

Ms. Veena stressed that practice this means that there should be the following:

- A change in attitudes supporting gender equality
- Concrete methods to integrate gender into the policy cycle

Later Ms. Veena in her talk she emphasized that-A gender-blind analysis does not take gender into account in the assessment or the evaluation of a policy or programme. Gender is a determinant in the social and economic outcomes of a programme or a policy for women and men. Hence start the change from your house.

Gender Mainstreaming benefits both women and men and do not increase inequality but enhance gender equality. Gender mainstreaming aims to solve –sometimes hidden– gender inequalities. It is therefore a tool for achieving gender equality.

She finally concluded saying that there is wide consensus about the effectiveness of a dual approach towards gender equality, combining gender mainstreaming and specific measures for the advancement of women, to ensure better policy making and better use of resources.
