








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ANNUAL GENDER SENSITZAION ACTION PLAN AND RELATED ACTIVITIES

Aparajitha - Women Empowerment Cell, SSMRV College - is a Cell which provides services that address the academic, social, emotional and personal development needs as

well as the health and safety concerns of Female and Male students of the college.

Education is life, wherein, it should enable women to perform their roles/duties effectively and confidently. Women should be made aware of their rights and responsibilities towards building good society.

The institute is committed to creating an Inclusive environment, taking care to cater to the needs of all sections and cultures of society. To ensure respectful and dignified behaviour and to maintain a standard at the workplace, the Institute sensitizes all the employees and follows up regularly. After admission, the new students are to bring to the sense of sensitization by regular sessions within the induction and the orientation programmes. From admission onwards the new students are to have their sessions with the psychological counselor to positively influence them for their learning and emotional well-being.

From the beginning, the new students are to provide a mentor (who will be a teacher of her department). Weekly meetings between the mentor and mentee are to be conducted for them to smoothen the burden of study and to ease the stress in the new atmosphere. To ensure equal and unbiased measures for everyone for their teaching & learning activities. For this "No Discrimination Policy" has been strictly followed by all means. To ensure equal rights and participations in regular cultural activities, sports, NCC, debate, celebrations, and performing arts, girl students are encouraged without any sign of gender discrimination.

Women faculties and staff members are given equal participations in different activities performed throughout the year.
