Objectives of the activity	 To provide free sanitary pads to female students, ensuring access to essential menstrual hygiene products. To promote awareness about the benefits of eco-friendly menstrual products, particularly Carmesi's biodegradable sanitary pads. To create an engaging and supportive atmosphere for discussions on menstrual health and hygiene. To foster a sense of empowerment and confidence among female students by addressing menstrual health in an open and inclusive environment. To create an engaging and supportive environment for students through games and giveaways. To encourage open discussions and break the stigma surrounding menstrual health.
Methodology	For the Carmesi Stall Event , the methodology was combination of experiential learning, participatory learning, and inquiry-based learning. These approaches were chosen to create a more engaging and informative environment for students, encouraging active involvement and critical thinking.



Outcome of activity	• Increased Awareness: Students gained a better
	understanding of menstrual health and the benefits of using
	eco-friendly menstrual products.
	• Free Product Distribution: Female students received
	Carmesi sanitary pads for free, promoting access to
	essential menstrual hygiene products.
	• Engagement through Activities: Interactive games and
	quizzes helped students actively engage with the topic of
	menstrual health and sustainability.
	• Reduction of Stigma : The event created an open space for
	students to discuss menstrual health, helping to reduce stigma
	and normalize conversations around menstruation.
	• Empowerment: Students were empowered to make
	informed, eco-conscious decisions about their menstrual
	health by learning about sustainable alternatives to
	traditional products.
	• Positive Feedback : Attendees expressed satisfaction with
	the event's educational and fun format, with many showing
	interest in adopting Carmesi's eco-friendly products .
Feedback	The feedback from the Carmesi Stall Event was very
	positive. Around 300 students participated, with both male and female students visiting the stall. Many students
	appreciated receiving free eco-friendly sanitary pads and
	showed interest in using Carmesi's biodegradable products
	after learning about their health and environmental
	benefits.
	The interactive games and quizzes made the event fun
	and informative. Students also felt empowered by open
	discussions on menstrual health, helping to reduce stigma
	and encourage more open conversations. In addition to
	learning about menstrual hygiene and sustainability,
	participants enjoyed winning goodies .
