Objectives of the activity	 To provide freshers with a platform to showcase their diverse talents. To foster creativity and encourage self-expression. To promote active participation in extracurricular activities and build student confidence. To recognize and celebrate individual talents, strengthening campus culture. To identify potential leaders and create networking opportunities among students.
Methodology	*Event Registration – online and in person *Events categorised as solo singing, mono acting, open mic, ramp walk, instrumental music, and photography to showcase different talents. * Events, like singing and acting, preliminary rounds filter participants for the final performances. *Event coordination and logistics were managed by a dedicated faculty team from the Cultural Committee of SSMRV College. * A panel of judges from different fields evaluated the performances based on creativity, skill, and presentation. * Students and faculty members were encouraged to



	actively support participants, creating a positive and engaging atmosphere. * Winning participants were recognized and awarded prizes.
Outcome of activity	 Many freshers took part in the event, showing more interest in extracurricular activities. Students displayed a variety of talents, such as singing, acting, fashion, and photography. Participants gained confidence by performing in front of an audience. The event encouraged teamwork and a sense of community among students. The event helped identify students with special skills for future opportunities. Both participants and the audience gave positive feedback, expressing interest in future events. Winners and top performers were awarded prizes and certificates.
